
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
Let your customers choose how much they'd like to pay for your ebook. Payhip also gives you access to Google analytics so you can find out where your customers came from. Because you'll only pay when you make a sale, Payhip is a great place to start out. It charges a 5% transaction fee with no setup or monthly fees to worry about.

Selz


Use Selz to sell digital books to your customers. Customers can even download your ebooks onto their Kindles. Selz also allows you to enforce download limits to prevent sharing. Selz offers four different pricing packages, from free to \$26.99 per month for unlimited books.


Sellfy

E-junkie

One of the biggest benefits of using E-junkie is the flat fees. There are no setup or transaction fees. The monthly subscription fee starts at just \$5 for up to 10 products.

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Independently publish with Kindle Direct Publishing to reach millions of readers.

Get to market fast. Publishing takes less than 5 minutes and your book appears on Kindle stores worldwide within 24-48 hours.

Amazon Kindle Direct Publishing (KDP) is the most popular marketplace for ebooks, but that doesn't necessarily mean it's the best option for selling your ebook. While you'll have access to millions of readers, you'll sacrifice a good chunk of your potential sales. Amazon KDP requires at least 30% of your royalties, sometimes up to 65%. Ouch. But the tradeoff is you'll have more visibility and Amazon will do a lot of your marketing for you.
